Hunters Education Program on Saturday, August 25 & Sunday August 26, 2018.

- Program consists of two days of classes, rain or shine. Saturday, Aug 25th - registration begins at 8:00 AM, and classes run from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Sunday's check in is at 11:00 AM, with classes starting at 11:30 AM and concluding at 4:30 PM.

- A DNR provided examination at the end of the class sessions will cover Safety, ethics responsibilities, black Powder, Archery basics, first aid / survival, rifle / shotgun basics, wildlife identification & conservation.

- Students will handle and fire rifles and shotguns during the course of instruction.

Instructors have been certified by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and are NRA field range certified.

- Participants are required to bring a lunch on Saturday, the 25th. Soda will be provided and a Walk-in cooler is available for storage of lunches.

- Students must submit a completed application (**electronic preferred via e-mail**) by August 21, 2018.
