The holidays are fast approaching and the hunting season is underway.

As of December 4th, Winter leagues will be starting, Skeet and 5-Stand with Trap the following week.

Dago night will be held on December 22nd. Please bring a dish to pass and food will be served at 6:30 pm. If you have never attended you are missing a great time.

If you are going to hunt on club property, please read the rules. They are posted on the bulletin board.

Shooting fees have increased to \$3.50 per round for trap and skeet due to increased costs of birds, shipping and fuel. 5-Stand remains at \$4.00 per round.

Please, no laughing – when you bring your dog to the club to run, please pick up after them. If it continues we may need to pass a club rule that all dogs must be on a leash. Please do not let that happen.

If you have bar duty and are told to open and/or close the 5-Stand please read the open and close sheet in the 5-Stand house. We are not releasing the cocking arms. Just pull the lid down and turn off all the breakers. Why, you ask? We have 8 machines we open and close 4 days a week. That is 32 birds we throw away every week. By the end of the year we've thrown away 1664 birds. That is roughly 12 cases of birds which costs \$200. Let's give it a try. Never walk in front of a machine if the arm is cocked.

Almost forgot – this year's Trunk or Treat was a big success. The kids really enjoyed it. I would like to thank Ryan Golden and his workers for the great job they did.
